Church and Computers: Words and Symbols (November 13-15)
What role will the computer in the future of the Church? Preparation: an early example for the use of computers in our Church and then with a range of popular-cultural activities, liturgical, catechetical, pastoral, look at the history of the computer and their personal and cultural contribution as well as the search and opportunities of Christian communication.
