



The Holy See Pavilion at EXPO Dubai

"Deepening the Connection" is the theme of the Holy See's Pavilion at the Universal Exhibition being held in Dubai on the general theme "Connecting Minds, Creating the Future" open until March 31, 2022. The Pavilion intends to be an encounter between aesthetics, science and faith



under the banner of fraternity and intercultural and interreligious dialogue. Its symbols are two historical encounters: St. Francis with Sultan Malik Al-Kāmil, which took place 800 years ago; and Pope Francis with the Grand Imam of Al-Azhar, Ahmad Al-Tayyib, in Abu Dhabi, on Feb. 4, 2019. The initiative seeks to give continuity to the Declaration on Human Fraternity for World Peace and Common Coexistence, and among the articles on display are important manuscripts from the Vatican Library: 1) The incipit of an Arabic translation (ca. 800-830) of Theon of Alexandria's Manual Tables (palimpsest fragment from the Bayt al-Ḥikmah in Baghdad); 2) the Liber Abbaci by Leonardo Pisano

(Fibonacci, c. 1170 - c. 1250) (on the introduction of Arabic numerals in the West) and 3) Observations on the Gregorian calendar reform by the Portuguese astronomer Tomás de Orta (d. 1594). (press release) (video presentation) (photo gallery)

On October 21 a symposium on Artificial Intelligence was organized by the Dicastery at the



Palazzo della Cancelleria with the collaboration of the German Embassy. It sought to promote informed conversation concerning the social and cultural impacts of Artificial Intelligence on humanity. Activities of the Superiors

• Cardinal **Gianfranco Ravasi** spoke to the meeting #MolteFedi2021: "Diremo io o noi? Sentieri per varcare la notte" (Video). He attended the opening sessions of the Synod of Bishops on Synodality and presided at a mass at S. Agnese marking the 4th Catacombs Day (news), and one at the Lay Centre marking its 35th anniversary where he blessed a



new icon "The Hospitality of Abraham and Sarah." He gave various interviews, including one to the Maltese ambassador, attended the pre-Cop Faith and Science Symposium in the Apostolic Palace, and a Courtyard of the Gentiles on Fashion at the Embassy of Italy to the

Holy See.

- Bishop **Tighe** also attended the opening of the Synod. Then he spoke about building consensus and trust to the International Convention of the Centesimus Annus Foundation on "Solidarity, Cooperation and Responsibility: the antidotes to fight injustices, inequalities and exclusions" and gave a talk to a European Parliament Conference on "Machine Translation: Driven By Humans, Powered By Technology".
- Bishop **Azevedo** also attended the opening of the Synod. He spoke at the Conference on Ecclesiastical Museums marking the 20th anniversary of the document on the <u>pastoral function of museums</u>, and was in Portugal to open a Museum of Mercy.
- Monsignor Polvani spoke at the International Theological Congress "The Wisdom of the Cross in a Plural World" (Sept 21-24) and was present at the Faith and Science: Towards COP26 event organized by the Secretariat of State and the Embassies to Italy and the UK.
