

Praedicate Evangelium - the reform of the Roman curia

The Holy Father has promulgated an apostolic constitution on the reform of the Roman curia, which foresees, among other things, the creation of a Dicastery for Culture and Education, as of June 5, 2022, into which we shall be transformed together with the Congregation for Catholic Education. In welcoming this step of the ongoing reform of the entire Church in missionary conversion, the Superiors and Staff have been reflecting on the apostolic constitution, particularly its Preamble, Principles and the relevant articles for the new dicastery, art. 153-162.

A Memorandum of Understanding with a Catholic University



A set of research and dialogue activities already underway in the spheres of education, culture and public strategy has been consolidated with the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding between the Dicastery and the Catholic University of the Sacred Heart (*News*).

A Courtyard of the Gentiles took place at the *Circolo degli Scacchi*, Mar. 29, on appropriate financial taxation and control for a good social cohesion with the contribution and presence of economic leaders and financial authorities (*news*).



Visitors have included the ambassadors of Italy, Peru, Senegal and Israel, the deputy head of mission of the UK, Senator Lucia Borgonzoni, the Italian Undersecretary for Cultural Heritage, an interreligious delegation from Denmark exploring Faith in the Public Square, Manfred Weber from the European People's Party, Consultor Alessandra Talamo, and Bishop Theodore Mascarenhas, a former collaborator.

Activities of the Superiors:

- Cardinal Gianfranco Ravasi opened a conference commemorating the 2nd centenary of
 the birth of father of the science of Christian archaeology Giovanni Battista de Rossi, Feb.
 23. He made an official visit to President Giuliano Amato at the Constitutional Court and
 appeared on TV recalling the figure of David M. Turoldo. He presided at the funeral of
 Professor Fabrizio Bisconti, Superintendent of the Pontifical Commission for Sacred
 Archaeology, who died suddenly.
- Together with curating the Charism and Creativity Conference, Bishop Carlos Alberto de Pinho Moreira Azevedo presided over the mass for the anniversary of the canonization of Sr. Paola Frassineti in St. Peter's Basilica, Mar.11, and was in Fatima, Mar. 24-26, for a Mariology conference, from where he joined the universal act of consecration and entrustment of Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
- Bishop Paul Tighe was in Bratislava to speak at the 3rd European Catholic Social Days on the cultural impact of the technological and digital transition, Mar. 18, (English version / Italian version). He led the Holy See delegation at the Meeting of Culture Ministers organized by the Council of Europe (Apr. 1)
- Mons. **Carlo Maria Polvani** has been developing contacts with the Italian Embassy to the Holy See and the Confagricoltura network in view of future collaborations, as well as the being engaged in the renewal of the Foundation *Cortile dei Gentili*.
- Mons. **Melchor Sánchez de Toca** spoke about "Education, Democracy and Sport" at a Conference organized by the Foundation *Gravissimum Educationis* "Educating to democracy in a fragmented world", Mar. 19, and at a symposium in Crotone, *Epos, Ethos, Paideia, Polis*, on the educational and welfare role or sport, Mar. 26-27.
